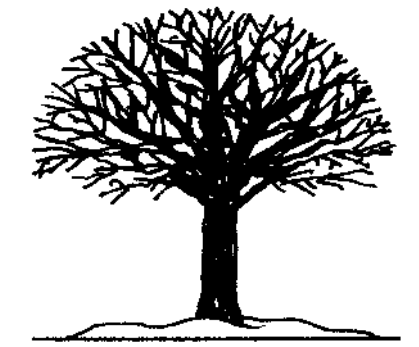

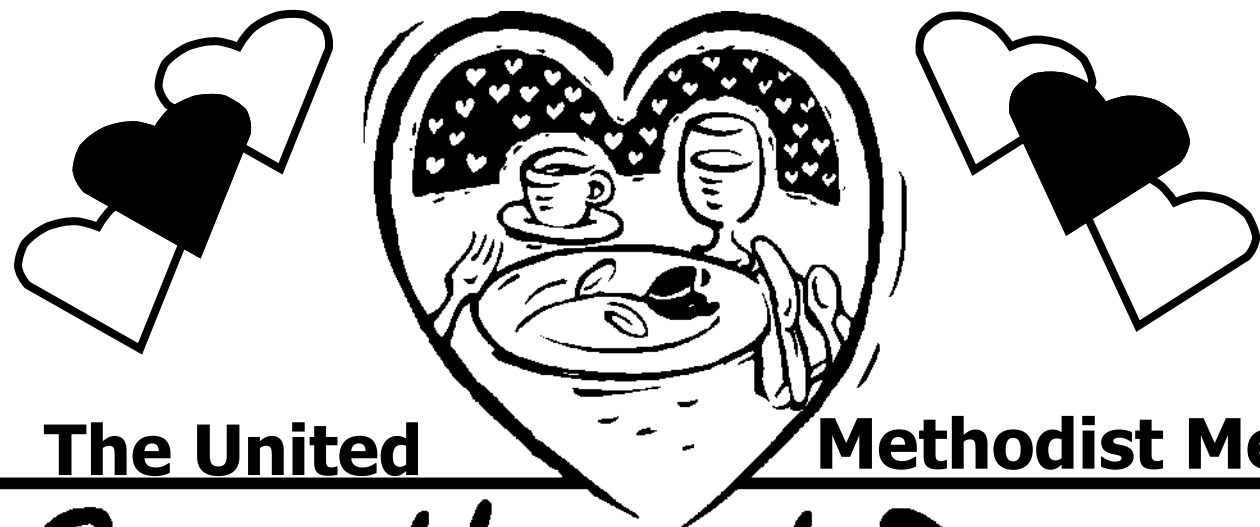

We will begin collecting peeled hardboiled eggs on **Sunday, January 30.**

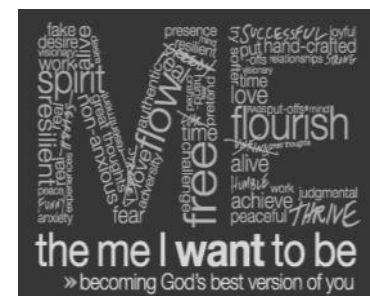

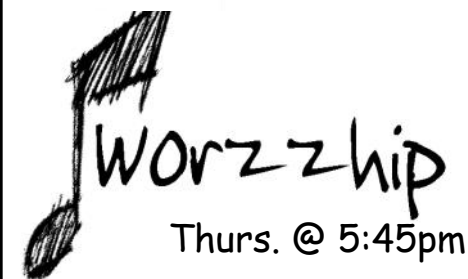
