Appeal for Help—In mid-October we received news from our friends in El Salvador that the devastating record rain has caused severed damage from flooding and landslides, isolating hundreds if not thousands of people from aid. Cecy Gomez, Director of Fundamuni, who facilitates our student missions, contacted us for help. At least 120 families who have lost their homes and crops in the villages where Fundamuni is currently working. The families are living in make-shift shelters and are without food and other resources. Fundamuni is making emergency kits consisting of food rations, blankets, mattresses, and personal hy-

giene items for \$25.00 per kit. If anyone would like to contribute a love offering to help out in this emergency, please make a donation to "El Salvador Relief". We will ensure the money is wired to Fundamuni as soon as possible.
