World Communion Offering, as it has in the previous 4 years, continues to support 17 youth from San Francisco Javier, El Salvador to attend a high school that prepares them for practical trades, such as accounting, welding, electronics or auto repair, and computer skills. SUMC and a mission from Spain have joined forces to provide for expenses, such as, tuition/fees, bus fare, lunch money. The students are selected by the community leadership. To date, about a dozen participants have graduated and nearly all were able to secure good jobs. This year's group is getting mostly A's and B's! Our mission goal is \$7500 to keep 17 in school next year.

Centennial Mission was started 2 years ago to provide a full annual university scholarship to an exceptional student from San Francisco Javier, El Salvador. Sandra Lunes, our recipient, will be entering her third year in a 5-year program at University Gerardo Barrias in Usulután. She has a double major in Business and Education and is doing very well academically and is also active in her community affairs. She enjoys teaching illiterate elderly adults how to read and write. For her to continue her studies we must raise \$2500 through this offering.
